Expectations in respect of all pupils, students, parents and guardians admitted in to the Cecchetti Ballet Associates.

Behaviour

Aggressive, abusive or anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated from parents whether in person or via email towards members of staff or other parents and children. Any incidents will be reported to Claire Hern and the matter dealt with. Pupils are expected to behave in a civilised and well-mannered way and to show respect to teachers, assistants and other pupils.

Children

Regular attendance is a vital part of the scheme. Children are expected to arrive punctually for their classes, in the correct uniform. Character shoes and skirts must be brought to every lesson. A name badge must also be worn at every lesson.

Mobile Phones

The use of mobile phones is strictly forbidden in classes and waiting areas.

Personal Property

Cecchetti Ballet Associates cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to your personal property. Please ensure all your personal items are clearly named we are not able to store lost property.

Fees

All fees must be paid by the stated date. Failure to do so may result in your child's place being rescinded.

Safeguarding

OTHER INFORMATION

- All registers are kept with the assistant for that class.
- To avoid injury, pupils must keep warm before class.
- Any pupil who feels unwell during a class, must inform the teacher immediately.
- Smoking is not permitted whilst waiting for your child.
- Parking is not allowed in the Rambert driveway.
- The fire evacuation procedure is clearly placed on the piano of each studio. Teachers are responsible for the safe evacuation of the students in their class along with the class assistant who will have a register and the students will be escorted out of the building to a place of safety at the front of the building.
